(A campfire. Crickets. The woods.)

## RILEY

Are you done?

## RENDER

No.

## RILEY

Okay because mine is getting cold.

## RENDER

It has to be perfect.

## RILEY

You're not close enough.

## RENDER

I am.

RILEY
Can I help you?

## RENDER

That is hilarious.

RILEY
What?

RENDER
Yeah, if I want mine burnt to a crisp, l'll ask.

RILEY
[Sigh...] Taiwan 1000, would you like help?

## TAIWAN

I wouldn't let you help me if you were the last human on Earth.

Of course, if you were the last human on earth, I could push you into the fire and then there would be no humans left.

I could use some help.

## RILEY

Forget it.

Crypto-Curious, you would think that months of camping would endow some of us with a certain skillset:

TAIWAN

## RILEY

Like cooking meals in a single skillet -

## TAIWAN

Well, that's you -

RENDER
Stop...

## RILEY

(RENDER growls, annoyed.)

## RILEY

Or Making Marshmellows!

## RENDER

Marshmallows.

## RILEY

Marshmellows.

## RENDER

Mallows. Marshmallows.

## RILEY

Oh, I see - you can pronounce it, you just can't toast them.

## RENDER

I beg your pardon!

## RILEY

The Observation Tower at Cape Canaveral is closer to the heat than you are.

## RENDER

Well the joke's on you because I don't know what any of that means.

## RILEY

Your marshmAllows are luke-warm.

## RENDER

Oh, just because I don't like mine charred beyond recognition.

## RILEY

They taste better.

## TAIWAN

Ugh. Does everything always have to be about taste to you?

## RILEY

I mean, if it's food...

## RENDER

The trick to a perfect marshm(AW)llow - [think: "Paolo"]

## RILEY

Please... you're killing me.

## RENDER

- is to find a nice spot with no fire, just embers and then slowly spit roast it until it's an adorable, golden, little puffer.


## RILEY

Crypto-Curious, it takes him forever.

## RENDER

And... it's... perfect. See?

## RILEY

It's beautiful, pal.

## RENDER

You ready?

## RILEY

I'm waiting for you.

## RENDER

Okay - one second.

Who wants to start?

## RILEY

Me. Dear god, me.
[Clearing the air:] I present to you - two graham cracker cookies.

## RENDER

A solid foundation

## RILEY

A fun-sized Almond Joy.

RENDER
A bold reinvention

## RILEY

Apricot jam

## RENDER

Reckless. Absolutely reckless.

## RILEY

All held in a tight orbit around a gooey, burnt-to-a-crisp, charcoal-black marsh-mellow.

## RENDER

Well, I find all of that intriguing, but it has left me with a mission-critical follow-up question...

## RILEY

Oh, has it?

## RENDER

Riley, that sounds delicious - but Does It S'more?
(RENDER eats his s'more.)

Oh... Oh! The balanced-mix of fruit and nuts - a Scavenger's delight!

## RILEY

So it was pretty alright?

## RENDER

Hi-octane Action. Nonstop thrills. Would watch the sequel.

But now you better have some binoculars in that observation tower, buckarini, because there's a new Monster of Mystery bringing the heat to this Cape Carnival.

## RILEY

I'm not going to correct any of that, but is there something I desperately need to tell you.

## RENDER

What?

## RILEY

I love you, so dearly.

## RENDER

Two graham crackers.

## RILEY

Vintage. A classic.

## RENDER

On this one: chocolate, marshmallow -

RILEY
A girl's best friend.

## RENDER

But what's this over here... Peanut butter?

RILEY
Oo - who's this bad boy sitting in the back of class?

RENDER
And on top of that - a strip of bacon.

RILEY
Wait - where did you get bacon?

RENDER
I stole it off your plate this morning.

## RILEY

Render!

## RENDER

You're getting it back.

## RILEY

Well that stolen piece of bacon may now be embroiled in one of the greatest heists ever attempted, but it's left the authorities with one, puzzling question:

Does It S'more?
(RILEY eats her s'more. RILEY is... a messy eater. TAIWAN bristles.)

## RENDER

So?

## RILEY

A laugh-a-minute riot. The feel-good comedy hit of the year. A must watch.

## TAIWAN

Here Riley, try mine!
(RILEY screams, you know the drill.)

## RILEY

Put that out.
(TAIWAN walks towards RILEY.)

TAIWAN
You'll like it, I promise.

RILEY
It's on fire!

## RENDER

Well you have to try it.

## RILEY

It's just a flaming marshmellow on a graham cracker. [to TAIWAN:] stop it.

RENDER
Mallow...

## RILEY

Is that dirt?

## TAIWAN

It's mostly fire and dirt.

## RENDER

Everyone else got a turn, you're making him feel left out.

## RILEY

You eat it.

## RENDER

Noooooo.
(TAIWAN is chasing RILEY around the campfire now.)

## TAIWAN

How do you know you don't like it if you won't try it?

## RENDER

He makes a solid point.

## RILEY

You are egging him on and you know it.

## RENDER

Yeah... I tell ya, Crypto-Curious... always a wild time at the Cape Carnival.

## RILEY

That's not even a real thing!

## TAIWAN

## Catch!

(Theme Song.)
(The 'Zzzzz' of rope against bark.)

## RILEY

Can it go a little higher?
(Another tug.)

## TAIWAN

Now?

## RILEY

That's good.

## RENDER

Taiwan 1000, you're so good with ropes.

## TAIWAN

My previous owner had a kid in Scouts. I used to read along with his Alta Vista search results.

## RENDER

That makes sense.

RILEY
Does it?

## RENDER

[turning, walking away:] Okay well, goodnight food, I love you.

## RILEY

Render, what's in your hands?

## RENDER

What?

## RILEY

You're walking all weird, with your hands together.

RENDER
It's just a thoughtful pose.

## RILEY

You've got food.

## RENDER

I do not.

## RILEY

How much?

## RENDER

[immediately:] One handful. One handful!

## RILEY

You were gonna take that in the tent. We just tree'd the food.

RENDER
Which is why I had to grab a handful.

RILEY
Well eat it.

RENDER
I'm not hungry. [conspiratorially:] This is for later.

RILEY
You can't have it "for later." You can't have food in the tent.

## RENDER

Oh come on - it's just a little bit? In case I can't sleep.

## RILEY

It will attract wild animals.

## RENDER

What wild animals?

## RILEY

Bears.

## RENDER

Are there bears?

## RILEY

Well no, not here.
RENDER

Ah-ha!

RILEY
You have to tree your food.

## TAIWAN

There are gators.

## RILEY

Thank you, Taiwan 1000. Yes. There are gators.

## RENDER

In these woods?

## RILEY

You saw the sign.

## RENDER

What sign? You mean the billboard?

## RILEY

Yeah.

## RENDER

Big Jay Erwin's Alligator Farm and Boot Emporium? That billboard?

RILEY
See? Gators.

## RENDER

Those aren't wild animals - that's a tourist trap!

RILEY
Where do you think Big Jay Erwin's alligators come from?

## RENDER

Do you really think any of them are left in the wild with Big Jay Erwin on the case?
RENDER (cont.)
Plus, look how high up you put everything. How big are these gators?

## RILEY

That's what you're supposed to do.

## RENDER

Gators are low to the ground. You could have hung the food at waist height -

## RILEY

Like a Pinata?

## RENDER

Yes, thank you, a little snack pinata. Then we could have gotten handfuls whenever we needed them. This makes it look like there are 50 -foot gators lurking around.

## RILEY

Ok - uh - don't speak it into existence.

## RENDER

What?

## RILEY

You know what kind of nonsense we run into - don't speak 50-foot gators into existence.

And no food!

## RENDER

Fine.
(a moment.)

## RILEY

What's wrong?

## RENDER

I get snacky when I'm nervous.

## RILEY

Yeah. I get snacky too. Want some help?
(RENDER opens his hands, they share snacks.)

It's gonna work out.

## RENDER

What if it doesn't?

## RILEY

It will.

## RENDER

Clues 1 and 2 from the Aghast! Menagerie turned up nothing.

## TAIWAN

Oh cool thanks Render.

## RENDER

Sorry.

## RILEY

And you're worried -

## RENDER

What if it happens again tomorrow? What if we get to the third clue and turn up nothing and now we don't have any more clues and we might never get the rest of the Menagerie - and and -

## RILEY

And what?

## RENDER

At what point do we admit that maybe we can't do this?

## RILEY

Yeah. That sounds like the kind of problem that calls for a handful of snacks.

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(They eat.)
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## RILEY (cont.)

My mom used to do this thing... when we were little. Dana and I would be in our room, ignoring each other, and the door would fly open and Mom would be standing there with her arms stretched out.

She had this green Air Force flight suit that she would wear. I have no idea where she got it. But imagine this curly-headed, forest green starfish standing over you, shouting:
"You've got two minutes to get your shoes on. It's Adventure Day." And then she would run off.

The three of us would pile in the car, destination unknown.

This one time we're driving - this crazy, winding deathtrap road that connected our neighborhood to the rest of the city - Mom's doing 40 while dancing to this AM jazz station when the sky opens up. ## RENDER

Riley?
(RENDER pulls her in for a big hug.)

Thanks.
(RILEY doesn't respond. They just linger in this hug. We hear rustling.)

## RILEY

Render... Are you wiping your grimy hands on the back of my shirt?

## RENDER

Mmm-hmm.
(That night. The tent. RILEY and RENDER are sleeping, which if you recall, both are Bad Bed Buddies. The sound of a Windows 95 machine waking up. TAIWAN stirs, sits up. Something is outside the tent.)

## TAIWAN

Render... Render wake up.
(TAIWAN smacks RENDER in the face with his keyboard. RENDER yelps, waking.)

## RENDER

Ow. What?

## TAIWAN

There's something outside the tent.

## RENDER

Ugh, go back to bed.

## TAIWAN

Did you hear me?

## RENDER

We'll take care of it in the morning.

## TAIWAN

There's something outside the tent.

## RENDER

What are you talking about?

TAIWAN
Like a - [growls...]

## RENDER

That's just Riley's stomach. You get used to it. Close your eyes.

## TAIWAN

No. Render -

## RENDER

There is nothing outside the tent.
(shuffle shuffle snort.)

Oh wow, there's something out there. Riley.
(nudge nudge)

Riley. You're such a hard sleeper...

TAIWAN
I got it.

RENDER
Wait, don't -

# (TAIWAN smacks RILEY in the face with his keyboard.) 

## RILEY

Ow!

## RENDER

Riley! (that was Taiwan 1000, not me) Riley -

## RILEY

That hurt.

## RENDER

Yeah yeah, not important, there's something outside.

RILEY
Yeah, Render, that's why they call it outside.

## RENDER

No seriously.

## TAIWAN

It was like a - [growls...]

## RILEY

It's probably just my stomach.

## RENDER

I already said that.

RILEY
Go back to -
(scratch scratch bellow.)

## RILEY (cont.)

There's something out there.

## RENDER

Yes we know.

## RILEY

No. There's like something ... big out there.

## RENDER

I wonder if it smells the food.

## RILEY

No because we tree'd all of the -

Render is there food in here?

## TAIWAN

He hides graham crackers in my floppy disc drive.
(TAIWAN ejects a graham cracker.)

## RILEY

Render!

## RENDER

I have regrets.
(step step grunt.)

## RILEY

We have to get out of this tent.

## RENDER

I agree. You draw it away and Taiwan 1000 and I will make a beeline for the Safari.

## RILEY

What? No! I'm not the diversion.

## RENDER

I'll give you the graham cracker.
(stamp stamp growl.)

If we stay in this tent, we are going to die. And I wouldn't want that for a lot of us.

## RILEY

Well we can't go out the front.

## TAIWAN

Well you can't be the diversion staying in here.

## RILEY

God I wish we bought a tent with two doors.

Render, do you have your pocket knife?

## RENDER

Yeah, it's in my bag.
(sniffle sniffle snap.)

## RILEY

now please now.
(RENDER looks for his bag, unzips it, digs around.)

## RENDER

Here.

## RILEY

Okay. [moaning:] sorry tent.
(RILEY slashes thru the back of the tent.)

## RILEY (cont.)

Alright - everyone out of the pool.
(Intense rustling and scrambling as the trio emerge from the tent.)

Can anybody see the - AAAH! - Gator!

## RENDER

Gator!
(There is indeed a large alligator, LAST, standing on the other side of the tent.)

## RILEY

Everybody keep the tent between you and the -

## RENDER

I don't think the tent is going to stop it.

## TAIWAN

You have to run in a zig-zag.

## RILEY

What?

## TAIWAN

Alligators are fast, thirty miles per hour in short bursts, but they can only charge in a straight line.
(general disbelief that TAIWAN knows this.)

My previous owner's kid did a science project on alligators. I read along with his -

## RILEY

Alta Vista search results, got it.

Okay, like we practiced:

## ALL

Run for it!
(They take off running. LAST tries to follow... It's hard. Finally:)

## LAST

Oh, no fair running in zig-zags!

## RILEY

Whoa whoa whoa hey!
(All stop.)
(The TRIO are all separated in the woods.)

Render, was that you?

RENDER
Just now?

RILEY
What are you doing way over there?

## RENDER

I was zig-zagging.

RILEY
The Safari's this way.

RENDER
There are no rules to zig zags.

## RILEY

Have you seen Taiwan 1000?

TAIWAN
Oh-ho - separated from the pack, are we?

RILEY
Nevermind, he's with me. Was that you shouting?

## RENDER

I thought that was you.

## LAST

It was me.
(eh, why not - they shout.)

## RENDER

What? What! Talking gator?! That is awesome.

## RILEY

See? What did I say? Speaking it into existence.

LAST
Hi.
(RENDER walks towards LAST.)

## RENDER

Hi! I can't believe this, you're amazing.

## RILEY

Hey babe - can we sidebar real quick?

## RENDER

Oh. [to LAST:] l'll be right back.
(The TRIO...)

Yeah, whats up?

## RILEY

What are you doing?

## RENDER

They said hi.

## RILEY

We don't walk towards alligators. Just a general rule.

## RENDER

We don't, unless they start talking to you.

## RILEY

Alligators can't talk.

## RENDER

Uh... hello?

## RILEY

Yeah, I see it too. Still... Alligators can't talk.

RENDER
What then? You think it's a Zeroks?

ALL
Trademark.

RILEY
No, it's far too pretty to be a Zeroks.

ALL
Trademark.

## RENDER

Well it has to be something.

TAIWAN
You know, you two overcomplicate everything.
[shouting:] Hey! Are you a real alligator?

LAST
... Rude.

TAIWAN
See? How hard was that?

RILEY
That didn't help.

RENDER
Let's just go over there.

## RILEY

No.

## RENDER

Riley -

## RILEY

Render!

## RENDER

Well we have to do something. They're in the middle of our campground.

## RILEY

Oh excuse me for not wanting to hang out with teeth that can move at thirty miles per hour.

LAST
I'm sorry. It's very hard for me to hear what y'all are saying. Could you do that a little closer?

## RENDER

Sorry. We're just talking about ... not you. We'll be right there.

## RILEY

[whispering:] This is a bad idea.

LAST
Yeah, sorry, the whispering makes it even harder.

## RENDER

Riley... Adventure Day.

## RILEY

[sighs] Adventure Day.

LAST
Oh, yes. Closer is so much better

## RILEY

Well that has an ominous Gingerbread Man vibe.
(The TRIO walk towards LAST.)

## RENDER

That would be a great s'more.

## RILEY

That's not the point I was making.

## RENDER

Gingerbread, toffee, marshmallow.

## RILEY

Can we come back to this?

## LAST

Hi. Thank you so much for not running. You have no idea how long it took me to get out here.

## RENDER

Oh, sure...

## RILEY

No problem...

LAST
I know it's late. But I was afraid if I came back in the morning I might miss you.

## RILEY

Why did you want to see us?

LAST
Not you. You.

## RENDER

Me?

## LAST

It's my fiance, Miles. We got separated, and now I can't find him. I'm worried something might have happened to him.

## RILEY

What do you mean "happened to him?"

## LAST

It's not like him to run off.

## RILEY

And your fiance -

LAST
Miles

## RILEY

Miles, he's also an alligator?

LAST
What? Obviously. [to RENDER:] what is her deal?

## RENDER

She's not used to talking alligators.

## RILEY

Oh sure, just me.

## RENDER

So you didn't sneak up on us because you smelled food in our tent?

## LAST

No.

## RENDER

Huh. Interesting.

LAST
Wait, you have food?

## RENDER

Graham crackers. Want one?

LAST

Sure.

## TAIWAN

Open wide.
(LAST opens wide. Another graham cracker ejects from TAIWAN'S floppy disc drive. LAST chomps down.)

LAST
Ew. Gross. Plain.

## RILEY

How long has Miles been missing?

LAST
It's been two weeks now.

## RENDER

Any idea where he could have gone?

## LAST

He wouldn't go out on his own, not without telling me. Unless... something happened to him.

## RENDER

Like what?

## RILEY

Like Big Jay Erwin.

LAST
If Big Jay Erwin has him... I don't even want to think about it.

But then I saw you walking in the woods -

## RENDER

Me?

LAST
And I just knew everything would be ok. You'll help me, won't you? You'll find Miles.

## RENDER

Oh. Uh...

## RILEY

Are you asking if we'll sneak into an alligator farm to look for your fiance?

LAST
You'll do it?

## TAIWAN

Yes. Riley will do this for you.

## RILEY

Look, I don't think that's really something that we ...

LAST
But you have to. It's true what they say about you, isn't it?

## RENDER

About me?

## LAST

If you're in trouble, find a Rubilee.
(Stunned silence.)

## RENDER

Is that what I am?

## LAST

Uh. Yeah. You didn't know?

## RENDER

No. I didn't.

## LAST

You're a Rubilee.

RENDER

Riley. I'm a Rubilee.
[to LAST:] Hi. I'm Render.

## LAST

Very nice to meet you, Render.

I'm Last Liquor Store for One Hundred.

## RILEY

Oh ...
(Later. Deep in woods, approaching the perimeter to Big Jay Erwin's farm. The ground is a lot sloshier.)

## RILEY

[yelling:] Pick up the pace, you three - the river's just down this embankment.

Crypto-Curious, this has been one of the more bizarre nights of my life ... which I think is saying something...

## RILEY (cont.)

For the last few hours, the three of us have been walking hip to hip with an alligator and I would just like it known - when our bones turn up one day - that this alligator didn't fool me.

But Render's all in on this one so ... here we are.
(The others join back up with RILEY.)

## RENDER

Are we at the river?

## RILEY

Yeah. GPS isn't super helpful anymore - satellite shows just a lot of tree cover, but I think the entrance to the farm should be pretty close by.

Come on.

## TAIWAN

It's a little steep.

## LAST

If you want, you can climb on my back.

## RILEY

Like we're gonna fall for that.

## TAIWAN

Render?

## RENDER

I gotcha.
(RENDER places TAIWAN on LAST'S back. RILEY sighs.)

## RILEY

Alright - watch your footing everybody.
(The climb down towards the river.)

## RENDER

So - how did you and Miles meet.

## LAST

It's actually a really cute story.

So, I'm laying out on the side of the road - which is a pretty great place to sun yourself, sometimes a family will pull over and toss you Little Debbie snacks or hard-boiled eggs.

So I'm laying there, right, and this pair of joggers are coming down the road. And one of them says, "See? Told ya, Last Liquor Store for On Hundred Miles"

And the other one goes, "Look out Joel, alligators."

And they turn and go back the other way and I'm like alligators? It's just me.

And that's when Miles goes, "So which one are you? Last Liquor Store for One Hundred, or Miles?"

Can you believe that? My soulmate was sitting right there the whole time and I had no idea.

## RENDER

You didn't know he was there?

LAST
No! I mean ... I guess I could have turned and looked ... [incredulous:] but that sounds like a lot of work.

So I said, "I guess I'm Last Liquor Store for One Hundred." - and he said - "I guess I'm Miles," which is so like him.

## RENDER

That's a beautiful story.

LAST
Isn't it? That's how we met.

## RENDER

So romantic.

## RILEY

They were talking about the billboard.

LAST
What?

## RILEY

Yeah, we parked not far from it. The joggers weren't referring to you, they were referring to a sign.

LAST
Uh - we were right there.

They said, "Last Liquor Store for One Hundred" - "Miles," and there we were.

## RENDER

Seems pretty cut and dry to me.

## RILEY

So think they were naming you.

## LAST

No. You don't understand. Those are our names.

## RILEY

Right but... Is that what you called yourselves - before the joggers?

## LAST

I don't know what you ... [to RENDER:] What is this lady not understanding?

## RILEY

Didn't your parents give you a name?

## LAST

My parents! Oh?
(This thought has never occurred to LAST before.)

## LAST (cont.)

I mean, I guess they could have named us if they'd wanted to ... but that sounds like a lot of work.

## RENDER

I like your name.

## LAST

Thanks, Render.

## RILEY

I'm gonna run ahead. Seems like there's something up there.
(RILEY pulls ahead.)

## LAST

Your friend doesn't like me.

## RENDER

What? Riley likes everybody. I think you just make her a little nervous.

Me? Why?

## RENDER

I don't know ... oh, it's probably because she thinks you'll eat her.

## LAST

Not with that attitude.

## TAIWAN

Oh, give her a chance.

## RILEY

[off:] Hey! Up here!
(RENDER, LAST and TAIWAN rush ahead. RILEY grabs onto and shakes a large, chain-link fence.)

This is Big Jay Erwin's Alligator Farm alright ... Get a load of the sign. "Trespassers Will Be Eaten."

LAST
Do you see Miles?

## RILEY

I don't see anybody.

## RENDER

What's that over there?

## RILEY

Crypto-Curious, this fence stands between us and a small lake - and on the far side, a little sandy shore and, it's a little too dark to be certain, maybe a wooden boardwalk.

And yeah. On that little shore. And on that wooden boardwalk. Hundreds of ...

Okay, I think we've brought you about as far as we can.

You're quitting?

## RENDER

Riley?

## LAST

You can't quit.

## RENDER

We can't stop now.

## RILEY

We got you to the farm. If Miles is in there - you don't need our help finding him.

TAIWAN
You could at least go in and scope it out for us.

At the very least.

## RILEY

Look, Last Liquor Store for One Hundred - I hope you find your fiance - I truly do. But this is as far as we can go.

LAST
Is that true, Render?

## RENDER

I... uh...

## LAST

If you're in trouble, look for a Rubilee. That's what they always say.

I guess it isn't true.
(RENDER caves.)

## RENDER

I'll help.

You will?

## RILEY

Ren ...

## RENDER

If Miles is in there - we're gonna find him. And we're gonna get you two back together.

Riley, I have to. I just do. If you want to stay here.

## RILEY

Are you serious? [sigh:] No. I'm in.

But how are we getting past this? If alligators could scale fences this one wouldn't be here.

## RENDER

Why would you put a no trespassing sign all the way out here?

Look, crossing the river, it's a sliding gate.

I'll swim across and unlatch it and you pull it open.

## RILEY

You're not thinking about getting in that river?

## RENDER

Oh relax - we're on this side of the fence - what could possibly be in the water?

## RILEY

Well now that you've spoken it into existence ...

## RENDER

I'll be right back.
(RENDER wades into the river and across.)

## RILEY

How is it?

## RENDER

It's really shallow. Kinda squishy tho. My feet keep sinking.
(RENDER undoes a chain.)

There - give it a tug.
(RILEY grunts and tugs, pulling the gate open.)

## RILEY

Ok, well, we're not on the right side of the fence anymore, so hurry on back, will ya?

## RENDER

Sure thing.

## RILEY

[to LAST:] Look. The fence is open, you can swim in and look all you like? You don't need our help any more.

You need to tell Render you don't need him anymore.

LAST
He wants to help. You're the one holding him back.
(LAST wades into the river.)

Water's getting deeper, Taiwan 1000, you might want to move up and sit on my head.

TAIWAN
Oh! Don't mind if I do.

## RENDER

Riley, you coming?!

## RILEY

[resigned:] be right there!
(Big Jay Erwin's Alligator Farm. There are a ton of alligators here.)

# CIGARETTES SOLD AT STATE MINIMUM 

Hey - get up - you're not gonna believe this!

## CROSS TRAFFIC DOES NOT STOP

What?! I was sleeping.

## NO PASSING SCHOOL ZONE

Where'd they come from?

POWERBALL 138 MILLION
And who's that they've got with them?

## CROSS

What is it? I'm facing the wrong way.

## CIGARETTES

Well turn around.

CROSS
That sounds like a lot of work. Just describe it to me.

## NO PASSING

There's a human walking up from the wrong way. And there's one of us with them.

CIGARETTES
Looks like they're carrying something on their back and - is that ...

## POWERBALL

They've got a Rubilee with them!

## CROSS

A Rubilee! Alright, watch out, I'm turning around.

## RILEY

Render, are you sure about this?

## RENDER

I was a lot more certain about a hundred yards back.
(CIGARETTES approaches RENDER, a little too close.)

## CIGARETTES

Are you really a Rubilee?
(RENDER screams.)

RENDER
Uh. Hi. Yeah, I guess I am.

## CIGARETTES

I've never seen one of your kind before. You mind if I nuzzle up against you?

RENDER
Oh, uh ... sure?
(CIGARETTES nuzzles up against RENDER, purring.)

## POWERBALL

Oo! I want to do that!

NO PASSING
That sounds like a lot of work.

## POWERBALL

It's nice!

## NO PASSING

Oh, alright!

CROSS
You really are a Rubilee. In our little lake. Isn't that something?

## CIGARETTES

What brings you here, fella?

## RENDER

We're looking for someone?

His name is Miles. Has anybody seen him?

CROSS
Miles? You know a Miles?

POWERBALL
Uh ... you know, seems like maybe I did meet a Miles. I don't know.

## LAST

Well can't you remember?

## POWERBALL

That sounds like a lot of work ... hold on.

CIGARETTES
You know who would know. You should talk to Stumpy.

RILEY
Stumpy?

## NO PASSING

Oh yeah!

CROSS
Stumpy knows everybody here. He's been here longer than anybody.

POWERBALL
But I already put all this effort into remembering?

RENDER
Well did you remember?

## POWERBALL

[exhausted from the effort, or bored:] I don't know.

CROSS
Who's looking for him?

LAST
I am. I'm his fiance. I'm Last Liquor Store for One Hundred.

CROSS
Nice to meet you Last Liquor Store for One Hundred, I'm Cross Traffic Does Not Stop.

LAST
Nice to meet you too Cross Traffic Does Not Stop.

CROSS
This here's No Passing School Zone.

## NO PASSING

Hi there!

LAST
Hi .

## CIGARETTES

I'm Cigarettes Sold at State Minimum.

LAST
Nice to meet you.

## POWERBALL

And I'm Powerball 138 Million.

## RENDER

[to RILEY:] You getting all this?

## RILEY

Ugh - sounds like a lot of work.

LAST
Can y'all take me to meet Stumpy.

NO PASSING
Oh, he's just that way. You can't miss him -

## RILEY

Is he the one with three legs?

## NO PASSING

You know him?

## RILEY

Just a guess.

## RENDER

It was a good guess.

RILEY
Render! Really?

## NO PASSING

It's just that way -

## CROSS

Oh, come on - we'll all go with you.

## CIGARETTES

Sounds like a lot of work ...

## POWERBALL

Are you kidding - how often do you get to see a real-life Rubilee?

## CIGARETTES

Alright, I'm coming, I'm coming.

## NO PASSING

It's this way.
(They all walk down the boardwalk, passing scores of other alligators, all whispering:
("Is that a Rubilee?" - "she's got a Rubilee with her?" - "Where are they going with that Rubilee?" - etc.)

## RILEY

Well aren't you the life of the party.

## RENDER

I know.

Hey - I've got a question. And I'm not asking for any particular, "wouldn't it be fun if we did this" reason - but do you ever all line up in the water and let people run across your backs Live-and-Let-Die-style?
(There is an uproar of consternation from the Alligators:)
("What did he just say?" - "Is he being serious?" - "The nerve!")

Oh. Alright - I get it.
[to RILEY:] They prefer Sean Connery.
(And, yup, that's it. All the Alligators try on their best Sean Connery impersonations. RILEY, RENDER and TAIWAN join in:)
("Losers always whine about doing their best." - "You're all wet! But my martini's still dry." - "The name's Bond, James Bond." - "I am the last one!")

## RILEY

Was that a Dragonheart reference?

## RENDER

Nice.
(STUMPY hears all the commotion.)

## STUMPY

Who's that coming up the way?

## CROSS

She's looking for a friend.

My fiance.

## STUMPY

Well, if your fiance is here, I can help you sort that out. And who are your friends?

## RILEY

I'm Riley.

## RENDER

And I'm -

## STUMPY

Well my my - I haven't seen a Rubilee in quite some time. Hello.

RENDER
Hi. I'm Render.

## STUMPY

And I'm Fines Doubled When Workers Present. But my friends call me Stumpy.

## RENDER

Is that ... me? Do I call you Stumpy.

## STUMPY

... yeah.

## RENDER

Great, sorry, thought maybe it was a test.

## TAIWAN

Um ... I'm also here. I'm not just this alligator's hat. Taiwan 1000.

## STUMPY

And who are we looking for!

## TAIWAN

Oh, you weren't listening... got it.

LAST
Me. I'm looking for my fiance. His name is Miles.

## STUMPY

Miles? Hmm ... Miles ... Does seem like I've run into a Miles around here lately.

Was he about this tall?

LAST
Yeah.

## STUMPY

This long?

LAST
Yeah.

## STUMPY

## Green?

LAST
Yeah.

## STUMPY

Long snout?

LAST
Yeah.

## STUMPY

Whole buncha teeth?

## LAST

Yeah.

## STUMPY

Didn't have any stumps, did he?

LAST
No.

STUMPY
Hmm ... Does seem like l've seen somebody like that around here.

Oh, Miles! Yes, Miles!

Wait, then that would make you ... Last Liquor Store for One Hundred!

LAST
You've heard of me?

STUMPY
Heard of you! You're all he ever talks about. Lovely to meet you - lovely to meet you!

Somebody, quick, go and fetch Miles.
(And now a chorus of, " . . that sounds like a lot of work.")

Oh alright, just down the line for him.
(A game of telephone - "Miles!" - "Miles! - "Have you seen Miles?" - "Go get Miles" "Miles!")
(MILES comes up from underwater right beside LAST.)

MILES
Last Liquor Store for One Hundred!

## LAST

Miles!

## STUMPY

Hold up! Hold up, everybody, he was already here.

## POWERBALL

Do we have to shout down the line again?

## STUMPY

No, that seems like a lot of work.

## LAST

You were right here the whole time?

## MILES

I was laying on the bottom with my snout sticking up. I thought I smelled you. I was honna come up and check ... but it seemed like a lot of work.

LAST
Darling, I was so worried.

MILES
I was afraid you might be. I was worried for you!

LAST
But I don't understand, what happened?

## MILES

It's a crazy story. A guy put me in the back of his truck. And now I'm here.

LAST
That's crazy.

## MILES

I know! I wanted to go back and find you, I thought about it all the time -

## RILEY, RENDER, TAIWAN

But it seemed like a lot of work.

LAST
And I wanted to come looking for you. It was all I thought about -

RILEY, RENDER, TAIWAN
But it seemed like a lot of work.

## MILES

So, how did you get here?

I found a Rubilee, just walking thru the woods, with his roadies.

## RILEY

Hey! We're not his -

## TAIWAN

I mean I get it. But I don't like it.

## MILES

You came all this way for me?

LAST
Of course! I would do anything for you.

## MILES

Oh, that makes me love you even more.

LAST
I love you, Miles.

## MILES

I love you, Last Liquor Store for One Hundred.

I just wanna ... bit you on your snout.
(HE does.)

LAST
I just want to bite you on your snout.
(SHE does.)
(THEY do. Alligator make-out session, which is mostly biting.)

## RILEY

Oh my, are you seeing this?

## RENDER

Who would dare look away.

## RILEY

Seems like that's gonna get infected.

## RENDER

So much tongue.

## TAIWAN

How is this not too much work?
(RILEY stops this love affair.)

## RILEY

Ok. This has to stop.

I just ... don't understand.

I've seen alligators before. In zoos, aquariums, at the beach. I've been to the Everrglades! And they don't talk. And they're not named after road signs or gas station marquees. And they don't ... make out!

I'm ... so confused.

## MILES

Oh. I can explain. You see:

We're lazy.
(All together:)

LAST
So lazy.

## NO PASSING

Yeah, we're lazy.

## CROSS

We're lazy.

## CIGARETTES

I'm exhausted just explaining it.

## MILES

We alligators learned a long time ago that if we just sit still and don't say anything you dumb humans will just walk up and hand us food.

## RILEY

You're on an alligator farm. Big Jay Erwin is gonna make boots out of you.

MILES
Oh sure, some of us. But if you want to lounge about in the sun all day getting fed raw chicken cutlets, every once in a while you're gonna get made into boots.

## RILEY

Every once in a while!

## RENDER

So ... are crocodiles monsters too?

## MILES

Crocodiles! Are you crazy? Crocodiles are big dumb green animals that live in the water.

## NO PASSING

Our snouts are different!

## STUMPY

Friends! Friends! Let's not let a reason to celebrate turn hostile. These people may not understand out ways, but they're still our ... honored guests.

LAST
Render, I can never thank you enough for what you've done for me. And Miles.

## RENDER

Well, of course. Seeing you happy makes me happy.

LAST
Well, if I may, as a token of my thanks ... I would like to honor you with my mouth.

## RENDER

I'm sorry, what?

## RILEY

[vindicated:] There it is.

## MOUTH

Actually, we'd like to honor all three of you with our mouths.

## RENDER

I don't think I understand.

## LAST

We open our mouths.

## MILES

You lay across them.

LAST
And we ...

## BOTH

Honor you.

## RENDER

I'm just having a hard time understanding the -

## RILEY

Eat you. They want to eat you.

## CIGARETTES

I want to honor you with my mouth.

## CROSS

Me too - I'd like to honor you.

## POWERBALL

Can I honor you with my mouth?

## NO PASSING

I wanna do some mouth honorin'!

## TAIWAN

Ok, Riley - I can't believe I'm saying this. As much as I would like you to be eaten, I very much would like to live which, unfortunately, means I need you to live.

I'll get the big one - you figure out how to get us out of this.

## RILEY

Oh, Taiwan 1000-I knew how we were getting out of this the second we walked in.

## TAIWAN

Render, pick me up.

RENDER
Yep.

## RILEY

Like we practiced - 1, 2, 3 -

## ALL THREE

Run for it!
(RILEY, RENDER and TAIWAN run for it.)

## STUMPY

Don't let them get away!

NO PASSING
I was gonna honor you!

CIGARETTES
No fair zig-zagging!

## RENDER

Riley?

## RILEY

[from far off:] Render! What are you doing over there! RENDER
There are no rules to zig-zags!

## RILEY

Keep moving and stay close to the water!

## RENDER

What are you going to do?

## RILEY

What does it look like?

## RENDER

Is that airboat? That is awesome.

## TAIWAN

Render, we gotta keep moving.

## MILES

Mind if I honor you with my mouth?
(RENDER screams. Runs.)

## RENDER

They're coming at us from both sides.

## TAIWAN

We can go down that dock.
(RILEY cranks the airboat.)

## RENDER

Now what do we do? We can't go any further.

## RILEY

Render I'm coming.
(A door opens. BIG JAY ERWIN comes outside to see what all the commotion is about.)

BIG JAY
What in the world is going on out here.

## STUMPY

It's Big Jay - everybody freeze!

BIG JAY
Those teenagers are stealing my airboat again!

## RENDER

Teenagers?

## TAIWAN

She wishes.

BIG JAY
Momma - get me my big gator whomping stick!

## LAST

Render - you can't leave yet.

## RENDER

Last Liquor Store For One Hundred - you can really want to do this!

## LAST

I'm gonna make a wedding cake out of you.

## RENDER

Riley's not gonna make it here in time.

## TAIWAN

Render look at the alligators in the water, floating in a neat row ... like stepping stones.

## RENDER

Live and Let Die!

## TAIWAN

Let's Roger Moore these monsters!
(LAST lunges forward, her mouth open. RENDER leaps.)

## CIGARETTES

Are they doing what I think they're -
(SPLOOSH)

## CROSS

You know this is in pretty poor taste!
(SPLOOSH)

## NO PASSING

I'd move, but it seems like a lot of -
(SPLOOSH)

POWERBALL
Do you ever wish Timothy Dalton made a third film?
(SPLOOSH)
(The airboat makes it in time. RENDER and TAIWAN crash down, sliding away on the water.)
(TAIWAN is playing "Live and Let Die" thru his speakers.)

## RENDER

Is that Paul McCartney and Wings?

## TAIWAN

My owner's kid downloaded it from Napster?

## RENDER

It's a terrible mp3 quality.

## TAIWAN

I think there's water in my speaker.
(The next morning. Loading the GMC Safari.)

## RENDER

Well Crypto-Curious - I have to hand it to Riley's mother. After we left the lake, we got a little lost on that river. But Riley made a bunch of random left and right turns and ... we made it back to camp.

## RILEY

... you have no choice but to end up where you're supposed to be.

All loaded up?

## RENDER

All set. Are we keeping the tent?

## RILEY

I figured we can tape it back together. Did you get the food down?

## RENDER

You're not gonna believe this. The bag was empty. Maybe there really are 50 foot -
(RILEY clamps his moth shut.)

## RILEY

Quit. Speaking it. Into existence.

## RENDER

You don't think we should investigate?

## RILEY

Render, last night was all shenanigans. We're gonna be at the third clue by tonight, which will almost certainly be all shenanigans. But, between here and there, we are officially in a shenanigan-free zone.

## RILEY

Besides - we've already got another stop to make.
[to herself:] And if we don't do it now, my understanding is we can't do it for another 100 miles.

Load up everybody.
(RENDER climbs into the GMC Safari.)

## RILEY

Seatbelts?

## RENDER

Check.

## RILEY

Directions to the third clue?

## RENDER

Check.

## TAIWAN

Everybody got all their limbs?

## RILEY

Check.
(RILEY cranks the GMC Safari.)

## RENDER

All, Crypto-Curious, I guess that's it. And, Hey! I guess we'll see you again real soon!

And as they say where I'm from, "But Iris, if it's outside, then what's clawing at the basement door!"
(end of episode.)

## CREDITS
